Tommy Fantom (born July 6th, 1998) is a rapper, singer, and record producer born in Lymington, United Kingdom. He started getting into music around the age of 8, experimenting on guitars and pianos and writing songs with his friend. After a few years of living in his birthplace, his family moved to The Netherlands and relocated a couple times within the country. He spent most of his primal years in a small town near the Belgian border, before moving to Amsterdam on his own at the age of 16.

Growing up with his sister, Dutch mother and American father, there was always music playing around the house. Ranging from rock, pop to jazz, he was influenced early on. It wasn't until he heard his older sister playing west coast hiphop that he started to gain interest in the genre. He started listening to albums by Dr. Dre, 50 Cent and Eminem and he fell in love with hiphop.

Around the age of 13, Fantom started writing raps and recording them in his bedroom. At this time he drew inspiration from artists like Mac Miller, A\$AP Rocky, Joey Bada\$\$ and Kendrick Lamar. Fantom recorded and released two projects under his old moniker, which he later removed to start with a clean slate.

As of March 1st, 2019, Fantom started releasing new music, kicking it off with his first single "Not Today". Currently, he is preparing for the release of his 5th single 'Fine', produced by his friend and record producer Robert Ner. Fine will be released on December 27th.
